I JEWISH LAW

- Witnesses are essential to make a case
- Sanhedrin were to protect the accuser from false witness

II THE JEWISH TRIALS

- An arrest to be made must have the witnesses present
- The interrogation of Annas, the powerbroker behind the scenes, was illegal
- Caiaphas could not find credible witnesses
- Jesus chose to answer "I Am"
