- 1. Who truly has power here? Herod or God?
 - a. What does this tell you about how we ought to deal with persecution, opposition or difficult circumstances of any kind?
 - b. How does it make you feel that James was executed but Peter was not?
 - i. What is also true about God and following God besides your feelings about this?
- 2. How are you like the people in the prayer meeting?
 - a. What are you praying passionately for?
 - b. How might God be already answering your prayers in ways you are not expecting
- 3. What does it mean for you in your daily life that you have already died in/with Christ? (Romans 6, Galatians 2:20, Colossians 3:1-11)
 - a. How can knowing we are dead to the powers of sin and death, as well as our life being hidden with Christ in God encourage how you interact with people this week who do not know Jesus?
- 4. If you have not already done so, start making a list of the promises God has already given you in Christ. If you have, review it.
 - a. Ask God for one promise each day or for the week that He is wanting to show you how to live out more fully trusting in Him.
