1. What are your spiritual gifts? (or just your gifts in general?)
 - a. If you are not familiar with what the Bible says about spiritual gifts look at 1 Corinthians 12, Romans 12, Ephesians 4 and 1 Peter 4.
 - b. If you are not sure what your spiritual gifts are talk to one of your pastors.
 - c. The most critical question of all regarding the gifts you have been given by God is how are you using them to benefit others. Make a list of the spiritual gifts you believe you have and where you are using them currently.
 - d. After doing [c] look at the gifts and ask the Holy Spirit to reveal where God may want you to grow in where or how or to who you use your gifts to benefit others for the glory of Christ.
2. It would seem that in Corinth some believed that some spiritual gifts were better than others. Where have you heard or seen that attitude? Have you had that attitude yourself, valuing some people for their gifts over others?
 - a. What is God's attitude towards the value of gifts? (see 1 Corinthians 12:12-31)
3. How is the diversity of gifts given to followers of God related to the unity of God as Father, Son and Holy Spirit?
 - a. What is the goal for the gifts the Holy Spirit gives to followers of Jesus?
 - b. What is your goal for each day?
