- 1. Paul is contrasting two different ways to live with God, faith/promise vs. works/law. How would you describe these two different ways of following Jesus?
 - a. What are some of the attractions of each way of following God?
 - b. Only one of these two ways actually brings relationship and right standing with God. Which one?
 - i. How can the other way appear to bring these and yet actually do not?
- 2. What makes this passage difficult to understand for you?
 - a. What does this remind us about reading the Bible?
 - b. How important is it to remember that the Bible was written in a different culture?
 - c. What role does the Holy Spirit have in helping you hear God when you read the Bible?
- 3. Are you living 'free' in Christ, or are you living in the bondage of trying to win God's approval?
 - a. Do you feel/think that God loves you more when you do what is right?
 - b. Do you obey God because you feel that you 'have' to?

 Either of these show you are not living fully in the freedom Christ gives us.
 - c. How can you live out your freedom in Christ more fully?
