- 1. In what ways do people tamper with the message or person of Jesus to make it less offensive?
 - a. How is the cross of Jesus offensive to 'sinners'?
 - b. How is the cross of Jesus offensive to those who are 'religious', that is who believe their moral performance is what God wants/needs from them?
- 2. Verse 14 is a key verse as Paul closes this letter. It is a sort of summary of his message, of the implications of the gospel.
 - a. What does it mean to boast in what Christ has done?
 - b. How does the gospel change how we view approval and success from any source other than God (in other words, the world)?
 - c. Is your concern for making a good impression greater or lesser than it used to be?
- 3. In which areas of your life are you knowing the peace of living by the gospel?
 - a. In which are you forfeiting this peace by living for the world's approval?
- 4. If you had to sum up the message of Galatians in 2-3 sentences, what would you say?
- 5. What is the biggest lesson you've learned through our study of Galatians?
 - a. How is God calling you to apply that to your life?
 - b. Who else needs to hear that lesson/message?
