 - c. What would Jesus’ answer to the question above be according to:
 - i. Matthew 5:3
 - ii. Matthew 13:44-46

- 3) Jesus’ parables recorded in Matthew 13:44-46 say that we have to be willing to give up everything for the Kingdom of God.
 - a. What do you need to give up for more of the Kingdom of God in your life?
 - b. What potentially good priorities in your life may be competing with seeking the Kingdom of God first and foremost?

- 4) What makes the Kingdom of God more valuable than anything else in life? What does it offer us that nothing else can?
 - a. How can seeking the Kingdom of God free us from worry (and other fears or anxieties)
