Upside Down Kingdom Kingdom of God #3 – Matthew 5:3-10, 13:10-17 Sunday, October 12, 2014

Read Luke 6:20-26

This passage gives another contrast between the values of the Kingdom of God and the kingdoms of this world in the teaching of Jesus.

- 1. Some qualities that the kingdoms of the world value are found in vv.24-26. In your own words what are these qualities Jesus cites?
 - a. When have the people who have these things receive their reward from God?
 - b. Why does Jesus say 'woe' to them?
- 2. How do the values Jesus talks about in Matthew 5-7 & Luke 6:12-49 compare with the values that we are sold every day in our culture?
 - a. Read the passages and make a list of the values or qualities you see that Jesus affirms. Then look at those values and ask whether or not our culture also affirms those values or qualities.
- 3. Ask the Holy Spirit's guidance in answering this question:
 - a. Am I living a life where I am controlled by what the world says, or by the values Jesus honoured?
- 4. Consider what it means to be poor in spirit or to be materially poor. (Matthew 5:3, Luke 6:20)
 - a. What does a poor person offer to a king that a king would want or could use?
 - b. What does a poor person understand about any gift that is given to them by a king?
