- 1. What was the reason for the banquet in Jesus' parable?
 - a. What event is Jesus' parable referring to?
- 2. What do we see about those who were originally invited?
 - a. What is surprising about their response?
 - b. Who did the king eventually invite and why?
- 3. What was the problem with the one guest (v.11-12)?
 - a. What does it mean to be in the king's presence 'without wedding clothes'?
 - b. Why was this guest thrown out before the celebration?
- 4. What does this parable say about the Kingdom of God?
 - a. How would you describe how the guest of v.11-12 was near, but not in, the Kingdom of God?

Read Mark 12:28-34

5. In your own words, how important are the two commands Jesus names as the greatest?

- a. How much do you focus your attention on loving God and loving others as how to follow Jesus?
 - b. Who do you need in your life to fulfill these great commandments?
