Read 1 John 2:1-11

- 1. Look at verse 6. Pick the two or three words you think are the most important. What made you pick those?
 - a. The word from the original Greek that is translated 'live' or 'walk' has the meaning of 'following, making progress, regulating one's own life, conduct in life. What does this mean for how we live day to day?
 - b. Look at verse 11. What is the reason for John using the same word 'walk' or 'live' in this verse?
- 2. WWJD (What would Jesus do?) has some value for us to ask, but how might WDJD (What did Jesus do?) be more valuable for us?
 - a. In thinking about our identity?
 - b. In thinking about our calling as a disciple of Jesus?
- 3. Look at verse 8. How does this verse relate to verse 6?
 - a. How is 'love one another' both an old commandment and a new commandment?
- 4. Begin each day asking God who the brother or sister in Christ He is calling upon you to love that day.
