## **Reflections/Principles to Study & Apply**

A. 1 Kings, Chapter 18 recounts to us the events of Mt Carmel. God in a display of brilliant power declares his existence in an undisputable way.

What does this type of display of power tell us about who God is?

Does God still operate in similar displays of power today? Why or why not?

B. Spend some time and think about the most brilliant display of God's power that you have seen in your life personally. What is that event?

Is it a physical miracle or a heart that has been changed?

Although some displays of God's power may not be as dramatic as Mt Carmel but each display gives us a better understanding of who God is.

C. If the Holy Spirit displayed more power in your life, what would that look like?

How willing are you to operate, confident of the power of the Holy Spirit?

What do you need to change in your own life to provide more space for the Holy Spirit to work?

Spend some time in prayer with the Lord asking Him to move you to a new spirit.
