July 5, 2016 – Luke 3:21-22

Read Mark 1:14-39

1. Jesus had a very busy ministry. What kinds of activities were parts of His ministry?
 - a. How are these things like or unlike your daily life?
2. Where did Jesus go to pray?
 - a. What do you think the significance of this place was for Jesus?
 - b. Do you have a place that fulfills the same role in your life?
3. What do you think was the connection between Jesus' decision to make time for prayer and how he dealt with people's expectations? (v.35-39)
 - a. How can hearing from God help you discern how to respond to the expectations people have about or of you?
4. "You can do more than pray after you have prayed, but you can't do more than pray until you have prayed" – A.J. Gordon
 - a. How would this quote agree with the pattern of Jesus' life in relation to prayer and ministry?
 - b. Ask God where He may be calling you to pray more before you do more.
5. If you have the desire for more consistent times of prayer with God, what would it take for that to happen?
 - a. How motivated are you to see that happen?
 - b. Who could help you?
