- 1. Prayer is to be a humble request.
 - a. "Lord, Your will be done, Your Kingdom come
- 2. Personal prayer should be private
 - a. Matt. 6:5-6
- 3. Pray "in Jesus' name"
 - a. Praying according to His purposes and character
- 4. God answers the prayers of those who follow Jesus
 - a. Psalm 5
- 5. Pray without ceasing
 - a. We can always be bringing our hearts and minds to God, and looking for His as well
- 6. Pray with a willing to give and receive forgiveness
 - a. Matthew 6:12
- 7. Prayer is an act of faith
 - a. Matthew 21:21-22
- 8. It is the Holy Spirit that makes the connection to God
 - a. Romans 8:26-28
- 9. Prayer makes a difference, it is powerful
 - a. James 5:13-18

I pray these would help motivate and inspire you to go to God in prayer, believing He is present, will answer, and will make a difference in your life as you spend time with Him.
