- 4. What kind of unity exists between Jesus and God the Father that we are to not just enter into, but live in and live out as followers of Jesus?
- 5. How are your prayers for others like and unlike Jesus' prayer here?
 - a. Do your prayers reflect the short-term urgent, or the long-term (eternal) needs that people have?
 - b. What can you apply to your prayer life from this chapter and the example of Jesus?
- 6. How important to you is unity with other followers of Jesus?
 - a. How important was it in Jesus' prayer?
