Read Matthew 6:9-13, Luke 11:1-4

 - a. What is the difference between a model prayer and a formula for prayer?
- 2. If you could say to Jesus "Teach me to pray", what specific aspect(s) about prayer would you mean?

 - a. Now look at the order of the prayer, is there are reasoning you see for the order for the ideas Jesus gave here?

Read Luke 11:5-13

- 4. What is your current attitude towards prayer?
 - a. How do these words from Jesus encourage you in regard to praying to God?
- 5. When you hear or speak of God as "Father" what kind of images, positive or negative does that bring us for you?
 - a. Are any of those images hindering you from praying to your Heavenly Father, trusting His love for you?
- 6. How can you make the pattern of this prayer more active in your current practice of prayer?
