Principles to Reflect & Study

Listen first to the sermon on September 6th and use these notes to go deeper into what God is sharing with us.

The Command

Read Gen 6:5-22. In this passage we read of the commands that the LORD gave to Noah about the ark and the events that would come. Would Noah have ever had any doubts about the events to come? Do you think he ever questioned it?

The Task

Noah followed God in faith as he built the ark for weeks and months before the slightest hint of rain came. Noah followed God’s direction and did not lose sight of the vision that God had given him. What do you think helped Noah stay true and resolved in his execution of building the ark? Would he have ever been tempted to give up? Why?

Execution of Vision

Do you find it hard to hold on to a vision or desire that God gives you? Have you ever lost sight and given up on a vision or desire God gave you? What happened? What are the types of things that build your dedication and resolve to living the life God has called you to live?
